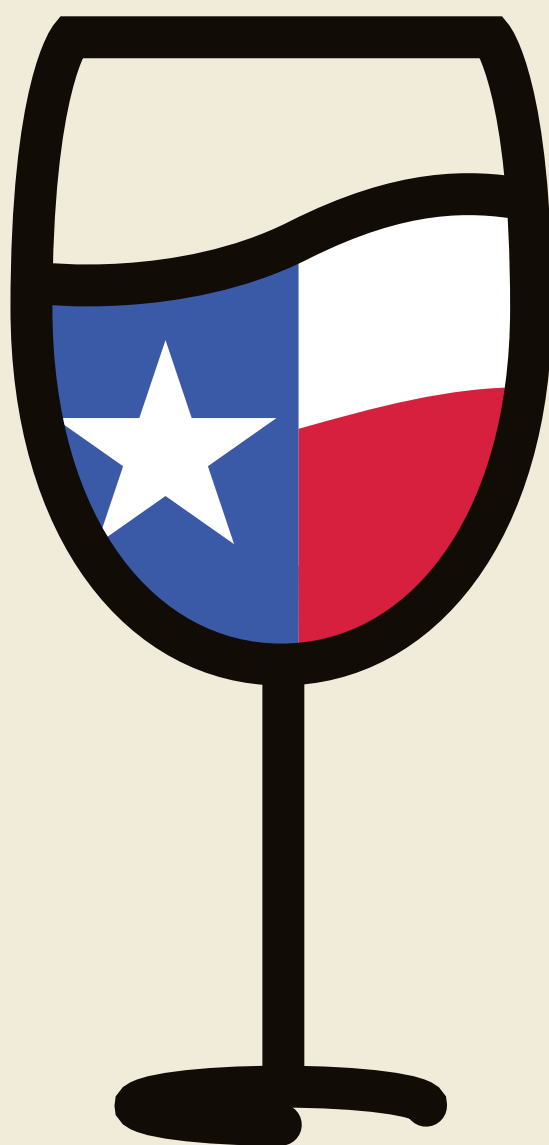

Home to Texas Tech University and a robust agriculture industry, the Lubbock area sits in the center of a region better known in the vino world as the Texas High Plains AVA, where nearly 90% of the state's wine grapes are grown. This wine-growing region boasts 75 varieties of grapes spanning across eight million acres between 24 counties. It's here where varietals that have become synonymous with Texas wine thrive, such as Viognier, Mourvèdre and Tempranillo.

But there is more than acres of sprawling grapevines to explore in Lubbock, Texas. Winemakers are putting their own twist on tradition by serving award-winning wine in newly restored historic spaces, like a revitalized Coca-Cola bottling plant and the Historic Kress Building. In fact, Lubbock boasts several award-winning wineries within city limits.

In between sips, you'll want to explore Lubbock's bustling Depot Entertainment District, known for eclectic spots like La Diosa Cellars, a Spanish-inspired restaurant where live music plays nearly every night. While in Lubbock, visitors browse local museums, which pay tribute to music legends at Buddy Holly Center; blaze the trail as the early pioneers of the South Plains did at the American Windmill Museum; and reach the outer bounds at the Museum of Texas Tech University with its own planetarium.

One thing is certain: you will be surrounded by hardworking, personable locals, each representing the genuine West Texas hospitality the region is known for.



LUBBOCK WINERIES & VINEYARDS

1 Burklee Hill Vineyards

Burklee Hill Vineyards made its way to downtown Lubbock in early 2020 with the opening of the tasting room located in the historic Kress Building. Guests are not only offered delicious, award-winning wine, but also a menu of hand-crafted food designed specifically for wine pairings. 3 Farmhouse Vineyards

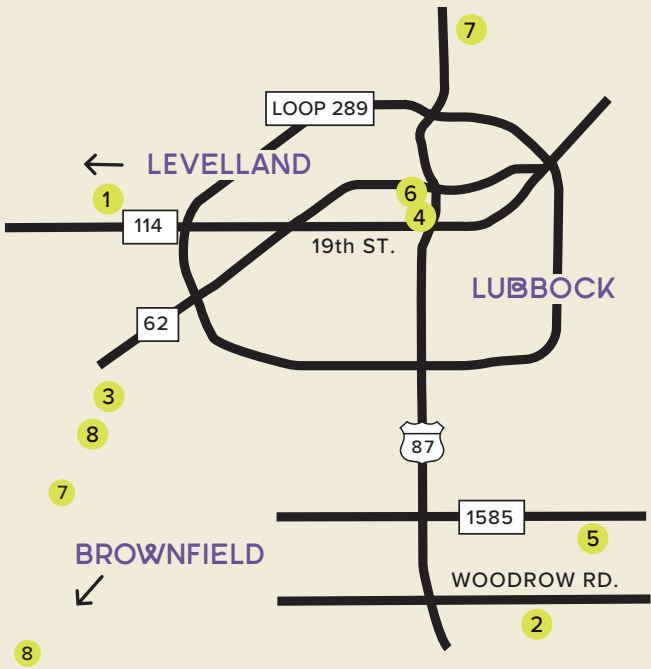

5 Llano Estacado Winery

The winemakers at Llano Estacado have been pioneers of Texas winemaking, and the winery is known for being the second oldest in the state. The new tasting room features more than 30 wines and a wraparound patio with views of Lubbock's cotton fields. 6 McPherson Cellars

The High Plains wine region owes a debt of gratitude to the McPherson family. Its patriarch, Dr. Clinton “Doc” McPherson, was the first grape grower in Texas to plant Sangiovese, now a signature Texas wine. Each wine produced at Pheasant Ridge Winery is made from grapes grown on the Pheasant Ridge vineyards, which are harvested by hand.
