

Boasting an undeniably *urban* wine scene, Grapevine is anything but wine *country*. Swirl, sniff and sip your way through wineries located right in the heart of the city alongside boutiques, restaurants and attractions.

For a crash course in the city's rich wine culture, plan your visit during GrapeFest®-A Texas Wine Experience, the largest wine festival in the southwest. Every September, GrapeFest® features fan-favorite events like the GrapeStomp and Champagne Cork Shoot-Off, along with the popular People's Choice Wine Tasting Classic, in which you get to play judge for the day.

The Grapevine Vintage Railroad is a can't-miss attraction for your Texas weekend wine tour, hosting several festive wine rides throughout the year. Look for the Jazz Wine Trains every spring and the Christmas Wine Trains during the holiday season to cruise in an authentic 1920s rail car as you sip on top Texas varietals.

The fun in Grapevine goes far beyond grapes. Bring the whole family along for memorable experiences you can only find in Grapevine, like Peppa Pig World of Play, LEGOLAND® Discovery Center and SEA LIFE Grapevine Aquarium, all conveniently located at Grapevine Mills Mall.

1 Bingham Family Vineyards

The Bingham family has been a pioneer of Texas agriculture for generations, and every wine is produced using grapes from the family's 200-acre vineyard in the Texas High Plains. In 2019, their wines took home a total of 42 awards in the Lone Star International Wine Competition, San Antonio Livestock & Rodeo Competition and Houston Rodeo Uncorked! 

Napkins at the ready! Get ready to dive into Grapevine's restaurants serving up everything from Lone Star staples to fine-dining specials.

Esparza's (817.481.4668) is a local favorite that's "famous for Tex-Mex and notorious for margaritas." **Winewood Grill** (817.421.0200) has an impressive wine list and showcases a seasonally-driven menu, while **Mí Día from Scratch** (817.421.4747) is known for elevated Tex-Mex.

Bob's Steak & Chop House (817.481.5555) should be on your list, as it's the ultimate upscale Texas steakhouse experience. Try Main Street Bistro & Bakery (817.424.4333) for a lineup of house-made soups, salads, sandwiches and pastries. Located inside Grapevine Main Station, Harvest Hall (817.251.3050) is a European-style food hall featuring seven globally-inspired kitchens.
